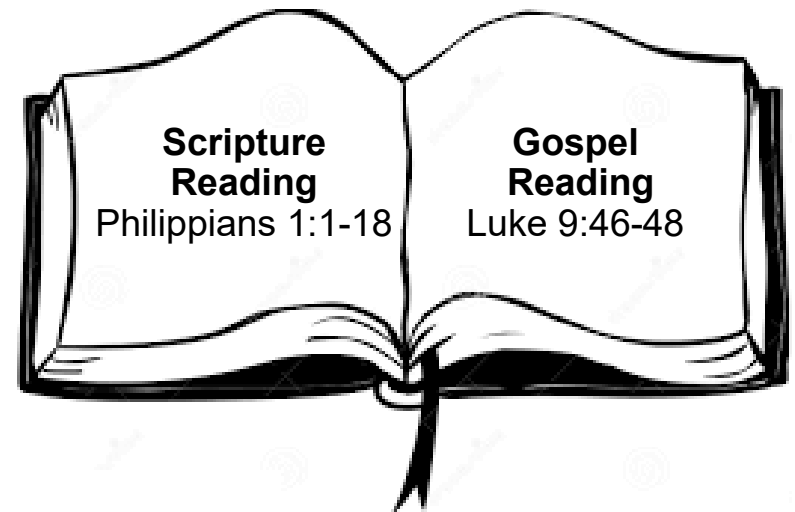

We have a very exciting opportunity to go to the Creation Museum in Petersburg, Kentucky this summer for a sleep-over. This would be a really fun trip for kids 10-18 years old. The cost is \$50 per person but includes 2 days at the Creation Museum with a sleepover in the museum with flashlight tours and special planetarium presentation. We will be given breakfast there before we can explore for the second day. This trip can only be done with 30 child participants and 4 adults, so we need everyone to pray about being able to go, and invite all your friends. We would leave very early on Thursday morning (probably around 5am) and would not return until very late Friday night (possibly after midnight). We would be able to sleep at church until parents would feel better about picking up kids Saturday morning. We are looking at Thursday, August 16th -Friday August 17th as the dates. But until we can guarantee the amount of participants needed, I cannot reserve the date with the Creation Museum. If that date is no longer available, we would choose any of the dates of that week to take the two day trip. So please check availability of August 12-17th in case we need to change.
