# 2) Fellowship and Service:

- SMALL GROUPS: Each Wednesday from 7:30- 8, everyone will meet in small groups. To discuss what they heard in that night's teaching or last Sunday's sermon (mentors will check on their Sermon Notes). And to pray together.
- In September and April all small groups will participate in ROADSIDE CLEANUP on roads around church (Town of Wyoming) as our <u>service project</u> (possibly at a time and day other than Wednesday evening) convenient to all group members. BE THERE—details to follow.
- Each week we'll eat together—SNACKS. Each student/ family can sign up to provide snacks. This is both <u>service and fellowship</u>.

#### **SERMON NOTES**

- Complete at least 26/year (September to August)

- Up to 5 from can be from listening to preaching/worship online.
- Blank sermon notes forms will be available under the Welcome Desk in Welcome Center OR you can download it from St. Peter's website (<u>www.stpetersstpauls.org</u>)
- Place completed sermon notes (or a signed worship bulletin from worshipping at a different congregation) in basket in Welcome Center—mentors will collect them so they can be recorded and discussed on Wednesday nights
- oAttend Sunday School weekly
- Participate in youth group activities [Pr Kay will get you info]

- oEach student may do any one or more of the following:
  - Acolyte (light candles on altar before worship & put them out after)—sign up for a month and do it every Sunday that month
  - Read Bible lessons in worship—you'll be assigned once every couple of months
  - oLearn to help with **tech in worship**—Lee and Tia will let you know when you can help/learn
  - Usher (with your family)—sign up for a month and do it every Sunday that month
