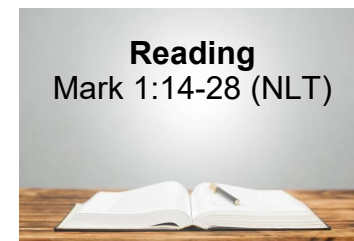

- ♦ Young children may come forward to receive a blessing
