3. Names spoken in Prayers of the Church during Sunday worship are broadcast via Facebook live.
4. There will be no reason given in the Announcement Bulletin or Newsletter, why the prayers are requested, unless requested by the individual or immediate family member. No reason will be spoken in the Prayers of the Church.
5. Prayer requests will be posted for four (4) weeks unless request is renewed by individual or immediate family member.
