Dear Friends,

We begin a new calendar year—Happy New Year!

- Annual Congregational Meeting on January 28, the Transition Team will report on its work and you will appoint a Call Committee (or Selection Committee).
- The Selection Committee will begin to seek candidates to interview as your next pastor.

May God continue to richly bless St. Peter's in its leadership and in its ministry in 2024 and beyond!

- 3. Names spoken in Prayers of the Church during Sunday worship are broadcast via Facebook live.
- 4. There will be no reason given in the Announcement Bulletin or Newsletter, why the prayers are requested, unless requested by the individual or immediate family member. No reason will be spoken in the Prayers of the Church.
- 5. Prayer requests will be posted for four (4) weeks unless request is renewed by individual or immediate family member.
- 6. This is separate from the Prayer Chain. For Prayer Chain requests contact Faye Miller at 715-445-4600.
